

## Park Regulations

Both waterfront parks on Tacoma Point are owned and operated by the volunteer membership of Tacoma Point Improvement Club. Each member is responsible for its proper use. No member has a right or privilege not granted to all members.

1. The park and its facilities are for the exclusive use by the Tacoma Point Improvement Club members and their guest(s). Make sure that the gates to the parks are locked at all times. After you have entered the park, make sure you lock the gate, especially those people who launch their boats. If someone is entering behind you, ask them to show you their key and membership pass.
2. Members will present their current membership pass upon the request of any member of the Board of Trustee or member of the Tacoma Point Improvement Club. On a periodic basis and during the peak summer season, park visitors may be asked for proof of membership. You are allowed to bring guests into the park but all guests must be accompanied by a member. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guest(s).
3. Groups over 13 people must make special arrangements with a Board Member. If you have not made special arrangements before hand, you will be asked to leave. For large groups, please make sure all garbage is disposed of properly and that members in your group park at your house and walk to the parks. For large groups, please use the pack it in, pack it out policy for garbage. Other members have the right to use the parks during a large party.
4. Members will assist in maintaining the appearance of the parks by placing all trash in provided receptacles,
5. There is no lifeguard on duty. Children under 13 years old who are using the swim area must be accompanied by a person who is 18 years or older.
6. No gas containers are allowed to be stored within the park. All gas containers must be stored either in your boat or in your car.
7. The boat launch is for park members only. You launch your boat at your own risk. Tacoma Point Improvement Club assumes no liability for damage to your boat , car or trailer. Boats are not allowed in the rope swim area. Boats are not allowed to tie up to the swim raft. Boats are allowed to tie up to the pier for loading and unloading of passengers. Parking is limited so after launching your boat please take your trailer home and leave your trailer at your house.
8. Parking is limited. Parking is for members on a first come basis. There is **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING**. No cars or trucks will be allowed to be parked inside the parks. **IF YOUR CAR OR TRUCK IS FOUND PARKED INSIDE THE PARKS IT WILL BE TOWED**. All unauthorized vehicles will be removed at the owner's expense.
9. No open fires on park property.
10. Trespassing and/or vandalism will be reported to the Pierce County Sheriff Department with no exceptions.
11. The parks close at dusk or at 10:00 PM whichever is first.
12. Violations of the above rules will be dealt with as prescribed in Article 11, Section 5, of the bylaws of the Tacoma Point Improvement Club Inc.
